VI. Building Year 3

- Erica Bennett reported to the committee the type of planning underway for Year 3 with its first class at TCC Southeast. Discussed the preparation for transportation, lunch, TCC registration, AVID scheduling, and Nurse Aid.
- Students questioned if there is only one ECHS counselor, how will ECHS provide emotional and social support at TCC. Who will help assist them transition with stress, anxiety and emotions.
 They depend on Counselor Stillings when she is present to help them work through their academic and outside stress.
- Mrs. Castrillo stated how we will handle textbooks next school year. How will we order books faster and more efficiently. Maybe rent textbooks as a cheaper option.
- Mrs. Bennett stated that we will have to revisit our textbook ordering process. As the textbook coordinator, she is looking at an efficient way to get books to students when needed.
- Students addressed concern that they didn't receive their textbooks on time, but a few weeks later then the start date of TCC classes.

VII. AVID Update

Instructor Gougler presented on the following AVID items:

- Certification year (In April)
- Four areas of certification that we must hit standard on.
- Either become meeting, merging, or sustaining
- We need to work on CSG's (Collaborate study groups), which is a less formal tutorial process
- Need to discover how AVID will work for juniors at TCC.
- Students addressed their need for AVID time their junior and senior year.

Bennett stated that we are looking at how we can support our students as a split campus, as we
have students at Timberview and at TCC. We have daily social emotional visits to our counselor's
office. What does this support look like next year.
