Admission Policy

Enrollment in the Mansfield Early College High School is by application only. <u>Current 8th grade students</u> from any MISD campus or who reside in MISD may attend. Interested students need to fully complete the application and meet deadlines for recruitment and registration.

- ✓ Mansfield Early College High School recruitment and enrollment processes shall identify, recruit, and enroll the subpopulations of at-risk students (as defined by PEIMS), including, but not limited to, students who are of limited English proficiency, students with disabilities, or students who have failed a state administered assessment. Enrollment decisions shall not be based on state assessment scores, discipline history, teacher recommendation, parent or student essays, minimum grade point average (GPA), or other criteria that create barriers for student enrollment.
- ✓ Mansfield ECHS shall identify, recruit, and enroll subpopulations (in addition to those who are at risk as defined by PEIMS) that are historically underrepresented in college courses (e.g., first generation college goers, males, students of low socioeconomic status, African Americans, Hispanics, and Native Americans.)

Students who do not meet the target recruitment may still apply and get accepted into the school.

In order to be considered for admission into the MISD Early College High School, you must:

- Be a current 8th grade student
- Complete the entire application
- Be a resident/approved transfer student of MISD
- Attach the most current academic record/report card (for non MISD students only)
- Demonstrate maturity and potential to matriculate through a college setting
- Complete the student interview process
- Commit to attend summer boot camp for one week
